

## Capital Credits Payment Approved

Gas prices have been soaring, and the cost of food is skyrocketing. It's time for a little relief. That's why we are especially pleased to notify you that payment of outstanding capital credits was approved for the sixteenth consecutive year by the Kingdom Board of Directors.

Capital credits are margins remaining after operating costs have been subtracted from the revenues of the cooperative. The capital credit dividends you receive represent a major benefit of membership in Kingdom Telephone Company.

Payments in 2008 will total approximately \$218,326. The formula for payout is 25% of the 1985 balance plus 10% of 2007 allocations. With the 2008 payment, Kingdom will have repaid in excess of \$10,918,000 to its cooperative owners. Your dividend check will be mailed by September 20.
